1/ Officials:

2/ Meeting/Eligibility:

Over the dates 31 May/1&2 June 2024, the Northumbrian Section of the VMCC Ltd will hold a road run for solo or sidecar motorcycles, tricycles and three wheelers which were manufactured by 31 December 1930. In addition, those motor cycles manufactured after December 1930 with girder forks in the original construction will be eligible. A list of all entrants will be provided when signing on.

3/ Classes

A Veteran: - Manufactured before Jan 1st 1915.

B Vintage: - Manufactured between Jan 1st 1915 & Dec 31st 1930.

C Girder Fork machine: - Manufactured after Jan 1st 1931

4/ Venue: -

The event will be based at Boe Rigg Camp Site, Charlton, Northumberland NE48 1PE. The venue has camping/caravan pitches and also bed/breakfast/self-catering facilities. Food and refreshments will be available on site. There will be a social get together on the Friday evening (31 May) at the onsite restaurant with food available if required. Signing on, will open at 09.00 hrs on Sat 1 June with the first machines waved off from Boe Rigg at 10.30 hrs. There will be a buffet provided on the evening of Sat 1 June at the Boe Rigg camp site.

5/ Routes and Event Format:

A route will be available on Sat 1 June. Route cards and an entry number will be supplied when signing on. There will be a lunch stop on route where refreshments will be available, at your own cost. A short social run will be organised for Sunday 2 June departing Boe Rigg at 10.30 hrs.

6/ Regulations & Rules for Riders, Passengers and Machines:

All machines, riders and passengers must comply with all legal requirements including an operative horn or audible warning device fitted to the machine in use. An MOT (if applicable) and valid insurance must be in place for the machine. Riding number cards will be provided when signing on and should be attached to your machines at all times during the event. A backup/breakdown service will be in place, so entrants are encouraged to stay on route to enable a timely pickup. A change of machine should be indicated when signing on and any incidents/accidents should be reported to event officials.

7/ Awards & Rules:

A/ Riders Choice Award: All entrants will be able to vote for the machine they would wish to own.

B/ Hadrian Award: Motorcycle and road safety questions will be asked at the start and at the lunch stop on the Saturday route for those who wish to participate. Awards will be made for each class and overall winner. In the event of any tie, the oldest machine will gain the award and if needed, the oldest rider will have the advantage.
