SATURDAY - First Bikes away at 7.30am from Spanish Battery, Tynemouth

BREAKFAST is at The Robin Hood Inn, East Wallhouses. Hand in your ticket to get fed!

LUNCH will be at The Fox and Pheasant Armthwaite. CA4 9PY
Food service will begin at 12.00p.m..

Payment: Your lunch should be paid to the pub on the day.

AFTERNOON TEA is at Mae's Tea Room in Uldale.

FINISH at Hartley's Beach Shop and Café with ice cream (or hot vimto!).

DINNER will be at The Queens Hotel, St.Bees at 7.00pm.

Please let the organiser know if you do not wish to travel this far on the route or onwards to Tynemouth. Breakdown will only be provided for those following the route.

BREAKDOWN

As always, there will be a van of shame following the bikes which will contain items to (hopefully) get you moving again should you stop. If, however, you suffer catastrophic mechanical failure, you and your bike will be given a lift to the next stop on our route, from which you can arrange your own passage onwards – it may be an idea to check your breakdown cover, just in case!

7. Add together the totals of entries and accommodations and send the grand total with your entry.
